

STAGE ONE YOUTH – ANTI-BULLYING POLICY

- WE DON'T accept any bullying behaviour — for example, name calling, physical violence, threats, being left out, spreading nasty rumours either in person or by text, email or on the internet (e.g. social networking sites for example Facebook and Twitter), hiding their belongs or any other way of making people feel bad
- WE DO have respect for everyone as individuals whatever their differences WE DO take bullying seriously — it's not "just a bit of fun"
- WE DO report bullying we see, whoever it's aimed at. It should be reported to a member of the Stage One Team or someone we trust
- WE DO take someone seriously if they tell us they are being bullied and we don't watch others being bullied without doing something
- WE DON'T just put up with bullying WE DO make sure something is done about it
